Dear Jennifer:

In response to brows with an elegant curve, I recommend brushing your eyebrows straight up with a brow brush and CAREFULLY trimming the hair from the inner brow to the outer brow. Remember to cut very little length (meaning height)! This will shorten the brows and define their shape. Also, shorten the length of the outer corner if needed. This will give you a defined arch. The brow should stop at the end of the brow bone. You can feel with your finger. Please e-mail me once you have finished.

If you want your hair color to have an ash hue, I recommend light ash blonde. If you want your hair to be golden, I recommend light golden blonde. And if you want Marilyn Monroe blonde, I recommend platinum.

Thanks very much---the only issue I have is in shaping the brows. I love the elegant curve--starting thicker and raising to a nice curved peak at

about the outside of the cornea (looking ahead); all the while getting narrower and then much steeper down turn coming almost to a point at the end of the eye.

I have 'plucked' the work the shape, but I am not there yet. Also, I see to have some white brow hairs and some dark ones in addition to the more dirty blonde. This is why I started looking a 'brown' color and gel to help shape. Do you recommend plucking or one of these 'home' wax kits with the template? It is really tough to get a nice symetric shape and not have it look to thin (I don't like the pencil thin look), esp. with the color variation. Any recs, as well as pointers on how to use the color and gel best would be appreciated.

thanks---looking forward to the shipment; hope to see you again next year. btw--the strawberry blonde wig works quite well; I guess I'd prefer a slightly lighter color (I am not sure what to call it--platinum or is that too light? I guess one tone lighter (is there light strwberry?)...and also longer and fuller in the back with a nice frame.
